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<u>Synopsis</u> :	This Ordinance is being presented by City Council for Council's review and approval. This Ordinance adds a new article under Chapter 5 of the City Code and requires funeral service providers to provide an informational sheet or packet regarding how to probate estates to the decedent's family or other representatives with whom funeral services are arranged. Many City residents are unaware of the need to probate estates or the benefits associated therewith, which contributes to title disputes for properties within the City. This Ordinance, by providing City residents access, through funeral service providers, to probate information, would facilitate smoother transfers of estate assets and reduce potential title disputes.
