- Funded by the National Collaborative of Gun Violence Researchers
- Examines why young African American men in high crime cities possess guns
- Phenomenological study combining community engaged research and grounded theory methodology
- 364 study participants in four cities (Baltimore, Houston, Jackson & Wilmington)
- The Center for Structural Equity served as the Wilmington Community Partner

Study Sample Study Participants System Inequities 93 interviews completed; 81 **Poverty** included in analysis. Housing Average: 18 years old **Educational** 56% juveniles between 15 and 17 years old **Opportunities** 44% adults between 18 and 24 Community Opportunities years old **Employment** Most living with mother and **Opportunities** Only 12% quit school; 80% liked Law Enforcement school **Experiences** 14% reported a mental health Juvenile and Criminal condition Justice Experience 9% reported foster care experience

Study Recommendations

Increase Community Involvement in Research

- CFSE Community Partner
 - Involved in all components of the research process
- · Action Research:
 - Presentations to disseminate findings and educate stakeholders
 - Action Planning to inform practice and policy

Enact Data Driven Policies

- · Only 2 participants owned a licensed gun.
- 77% possessed a gun before they were 15 years old.
- Most did not possess a gun all the time.
 They obtained a gun when they needed it.
- Participants support many current gun safety laws: age restrictions & buy back programs
- Additional suggestions: stop selling bullets
 & reduce the number of gun stores

Study Recommendations

Improve Police Training & Relations

- 1st interaction at 10 to 15 years old; only 10% for criminal activity
- "Made me feel belittled;" "...they don't listen;" "I was dizzy for 3 days"
- Participants need and want police in their community, but they want tactics and interactions to change.
 - "They don't have the right resources."
 - "They need to do their jobs better; not getting enough training."
 - "They think they are above the law. They harass people for fun."

Implement Behavioral Interventions

- 88% wish they had taken a different path; stayed in school or took school more seriously; continued to play sports.
- · 94% knew someone who had been shot
 - 37% before they were 10 years old
 - · 91% before they were 15 years old
- 81% knew someone who had been killed by a gun
 - · 43% before they were 10 years old
 - 93% before they were 15 years old
- Most possess a gun by 15 years old for social acceptance and protection.
