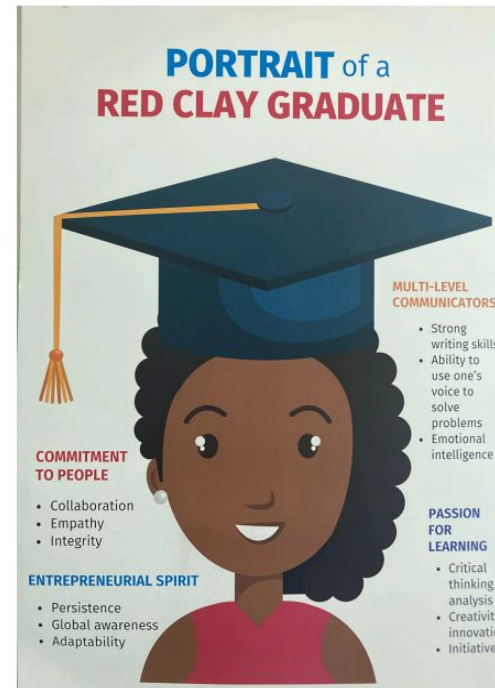

Advancement Via Individual Determination

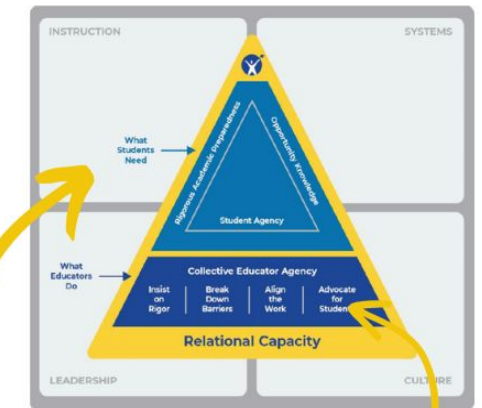
100% of all HS **AVID Students** are taking courses allowing them to meet 4-year college entrance requirements.

100% of 9th - 12th grade **AVID Students** are enrolled in at least one AP course as of SY 23-24. This is a tremendous increase from the prior year of enrollment (48% of 9th, 57% of 10th, 93% of 11th, and 31% of 12th Grade AVID Students).

12% of 8th Grade **AVID Students** are enrolled in Algebra 1 in comparison to 6% of Non-AVID students enrolled in Algebra 1.

Equitable College & Career Programming For Secondary Schools

Goal 1- Red Clay will increase the number of high school students participating in college-level coursework, ensuring access for all students, regardless of background.

- **Expansion of AP Seminar English 10**
 - **Boosts academic performance:** Taking AP Seminar in grade 10 sets students up for future high school success.
 - **Builds skills for the future:** Students build relevant skills foundational to success in all majors and careers.
 - **Engages more students:** Students who might otherwise not raise their hands for AP are likely to take AP Seminar to explore topics that interest them.
 - **Helps students stand out:** Helps students be recognized in the college admission process and earn college credit for qualifying scores.

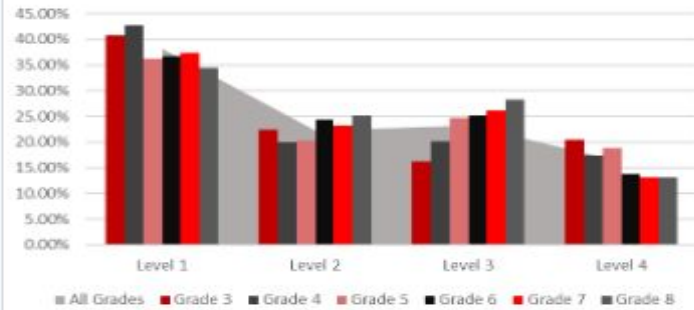

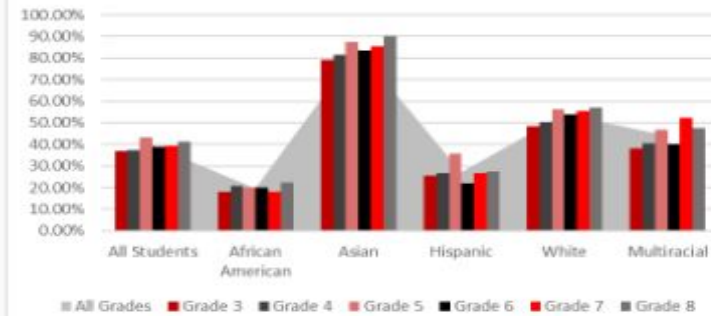

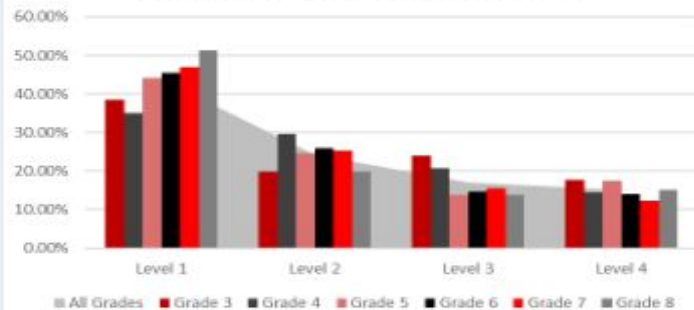

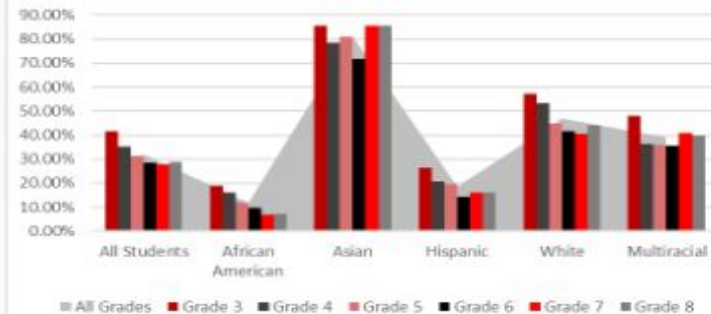

Enrollment, Programming, & Attendance Zones Path Forward & Charge

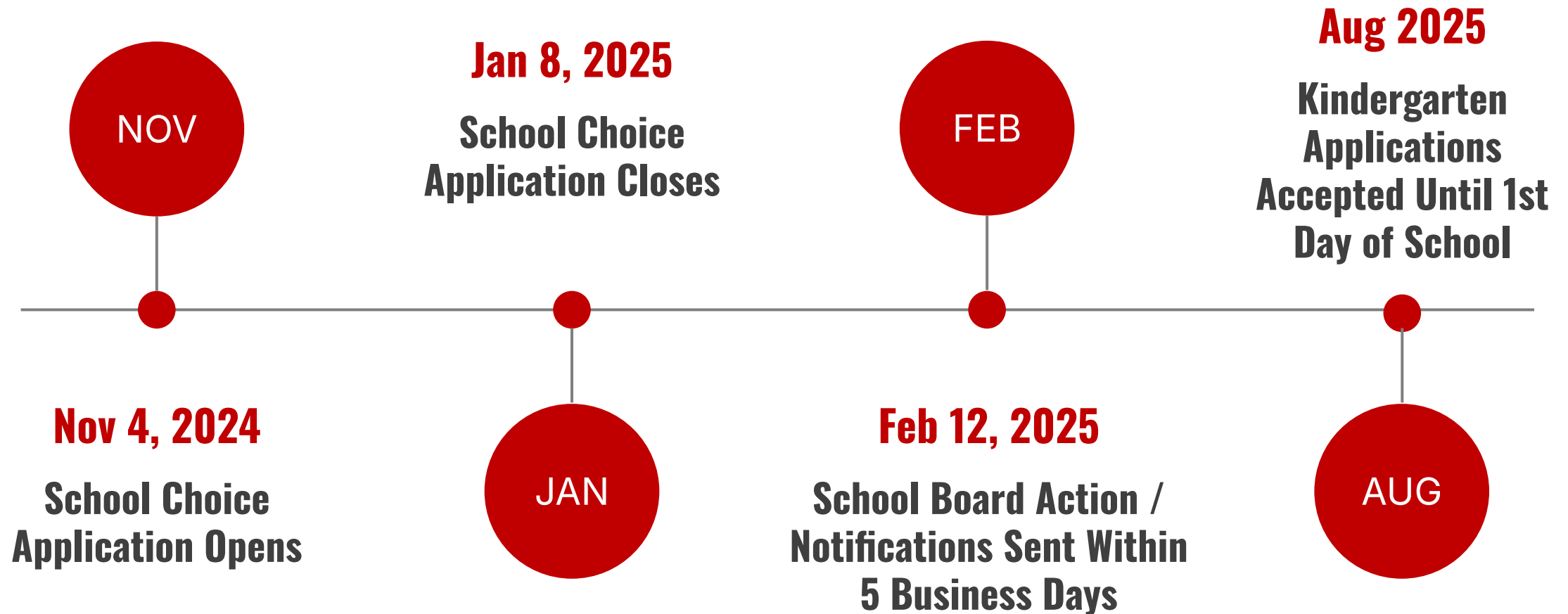

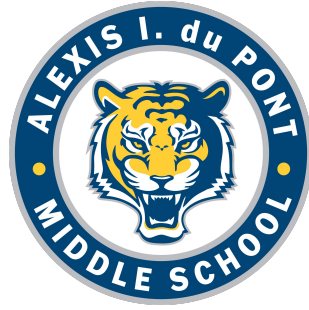

Early College Academy

Dual-enrollment partnership for high school students at **Alexis I. du Pont High School and Thomas McKean High School**, to earn both high school and college credits simultaneously.

Prepares students with the rigors of college coursework, coupled with outstanding high school supports.

High school seniors may be eligible for the “College Sophomore Distinction Diploma” on graduation day by earning up to 30 college credits.

This initiative allows students to earn college credits while still participating in the traditional high school experience.
