AN ORDINANCE TO AMEND CHAPTER 40 OF THE CITY CODE REGARDING THE ANNUAL SHOE ALLOWANCE FOR SAFETY SHOES

Council Member Oliver **WHEREAS**, Section 40-371 of the City Code provides for an annual shoe allowance for safety shoes for employees who are not covered by a collective bargaining agreement and who are required to wear safety shoes by their respective department head; and

WHEREAS, while the cost of safety shoes has increased since the enactment of City Code Section 40-371 in 2004, the shoe allowance has not been increased; and

WHEREAS, due to the cost increase of safety shoes, the Department of Human Resources would like to increase the annual shoe allowance to One Hundred Fifty Dollars (\$150.00); and

WHEREAS, in light of the foregoing, City Council deems it necessary and appropriate to amend Section 40-371 of the City Code to increase the annual allowance for safety shoes to One Hundred Fifty Dollars (\$150.00).

NOW, THEREFORE, THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF WILMINGTON HEREBY ORDAINS:

SECTION 1. Chapter 40 of the City Code is hereby amended by amending Section 40-371 thereof by deleting the stricken language and adding the underlined language to read as follows:

Sec. 40-371. - Allowances.

(c) Shoe allowance. All employees who are not covered by a collective bargaining agreement and who are required to wear safety shoes by the department head shall receive an annual allowance of \$100.00 \frac{150.00}{150.00}\$ for appropriate safety shoes. Employees may obtain the shoes either from an approved vendor selected by the city or may purchase the shoes from a vendor of their choice and apply for reimbursement. To qualify for reimbursement under this subsection, employees are required to present

the new shoes, along with a receipt for their purchase, to their immediate supervisor(s).

SECTION 2. This Ordinance shall become effective upon its passage by City Council and approval by the Mayor.
